MAIN DUTIES

1. WORKING WITH METAL/STEEL FOR SECURITY PURPOSES

- 1.1. Cuts metal and contracts door and windows burglar proofing for the Departmental Offices and Workshops to ensure security of properties.
- 1.2. Cuts metal and construct security gates for the departmental premises to strengthen security against thieves/robbers.

2. WORKING WITH METAL FOR RENOVATION AND REPAIRS

- 2.1. Build tractor draw bars used to tow tractor trailers in order to ensure that normal conservation activities are not hampered.
- 2.2. Renovates damaged trailers towing eyes to put them back into use.
